

A Saturday service will operate.
On 'Red Arrow' routes 507 and 521 a reduced Monday to Friday service will operate.
Routes 610 and 614 will not operate.
Route H50 will operate a normal Monday to Friday service.
Mobility routes will operate a normal Friday service.

From 1930 buses will be progressively withdrawn from central London as roads are closed. Buses will return to their normal line of route as roads are reopened.

The Greater London Bus Map

This map is a special edition for staff use prepared on behalf of Transport for London and London Buses showing bus routes running in Greater London on Boxing Day, 26th December 2004. It is based on The Greater London Bus Map which is produced three times a year showing all bus services running in Greater London, including school and night services. These maps incorporate a style similar to that used by London Transport during the late 1970s.

Regular issues of The Greater London Bus Map are not official publications of London Buses, but are produced privately by Mike Harris, sales of which have helped to raise over £12,000 for various charities. However the assistance and co-operation of London Buses and its staff is gratefully acknowledged. They are usually released in May and November and are available at £1.50 from Transport for London Travel Information Centres, London's Transport Museum and some other outlets.
